

## ANNEX 1 – TECHNICAL AND FORMAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The following parts of the application must be received to the Agency **in written within the given deadline:** 
  - a) part RD-A4 of the application signed by the principal investigator of the applicant organisation;
  - b) part RD-E of the application signed by the statutory representatives of the applicant organisation.
  - c) part RD-E of the application signed by the statutory representatives of the co-operating organisations
- 2. The Application must be submitted via the electronic Application system and must contain the following **electronic documents** in both Slovak and English:
  - a) part of the application RD-A to RD-E on the prescribed form;
  - b) part RD-F of the application on the prescribed form according to the binding scheme for basic research or applied research and development in Slovak or English only. The Part RD-F of the application (Obligatory scheme) must not exceed the maximum limit of 15 pages.<sup>1</sup>
  - c) structured professional CV of the principal investigator in Slovak or English only
- 3. The part of the application requested in paper form **must be identical** to the part of the Application submitted via the electronic system.
- 4. The part of the application RD-A4 05 must contain the ID of the researcher, i.e. the unique identifier of the principal investigator from the scientific database WoS Web of Science, Scopus or ORCID.
- 5. For the projects with their solution declared to be directly applied in practice, an inseparable part of the paper application comprises the **original or officially certified copy of the Letter of Intent on Applying the Project Findings** in Practice **between the Applicant and each purchaser** of the project findings referred to in part RD-B 04 (refers to a purchaser other than the applicant and also refers to a cooperating organization if listed as a purchaser) of the application, and in the prescribed form (Annex No. 7 to the Consolidated Version of the Call).

<sup>1</sup> In accordance with the requirements of the public call, the maximum number of pages of the Part RD-F of the application (Obligatory scheme) is **15 pages for Basic research and 15 pages for Applied research and Development**. Applications with an obligatory scheme exceeding the maximum number of pages at the time of submission shall not be subject of the evaluation process and will be rejected.
